Cough and cold season is upon us. Here are a few things we can do to reduce the spread of infection.

- Covering your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing, using a tissue when possible. Disposing of dirty tissues promptly and carefully.
- Washing your hands frequently with soap and water to reduce the spread of the virus from your hands to your face or to other people.

If you suspect that your child has signs and symptoms of swine flu you are asked to keep your child away from school until they have recovered and are free of symptoms. If children are prescribed antiviral drugs for treatment, they should also stay at home until they have finished the course. This is to avoid spreading the infection as much as possible. If anyone is concerned about flu-like symptoms they should phone their GP or NHS Direct on 0845 4647 for further advice.
